The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) has statutory requirement under the *South Australian National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972* to control pest animals and plants within National Parks.

DENR hereby issues intent to undertake a fox baiting program on beaches and associated tracks in the following areas:

- Piccaninnie Ponds from Victorian State Border to Green Point + Sect 707
- Germein Reserve
- Nene Valley Conservation Park
- Canunda National Park south to Cape Banks
- Beachport Conservation Park to Nora Crien
- Little Dip Conservation Park

This is part of a regionally coordinated program in conjunction with The South East Natural Resource Management Board and is part of a federally funded initiative for the protection of shorebirds in the Lower South East.
